Infants & Toddlers Program

We encourage you to make sure that you check your child's Daily Reports there are important information. Such as whether your child needs extra clothes, diapers, ointment, and wipes etc.

Comfort Emergency Kits

Please make sure that you have provided your child's school with a comfort emergency kit. This kit will be kept in your child's classroom in case of an emergency. Every year teachers will send the kits home so you can make sure that you remove any expired items and replaced them with new ones. We highly encourage all children to have their comfort kits while attending school.

Every start of the Week

Please make sure that water cups are filled up with water at the beginning of the week. Please refrain from bringing in juice. If you chose to take the water cup home every day, please make sure you bring it in every day filled up.

For naptime we need a sheet and a blanket please refrain from bringing in two sheets or two blankets.

Please make sure that snacks are inside a lunch box with an ice pack please do not bring snacks in a Ziplock bag, paper bag, or in a Tupper lunch tray. Green battery snacks are healthy snacks. We encourage you to limit sweets and provide disposable utensils if needed.
